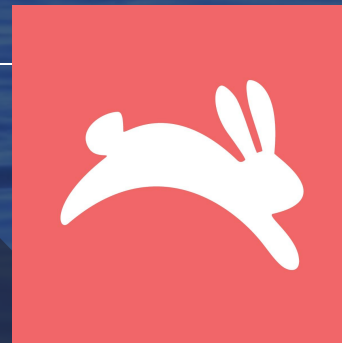

Cell Phone

T-Mobile Plan

Unlimited international data, 2G speeds, ~\$70/month. If you're going to switch to t-mobile, make sure you don't keep your old number.

Local SIM Card

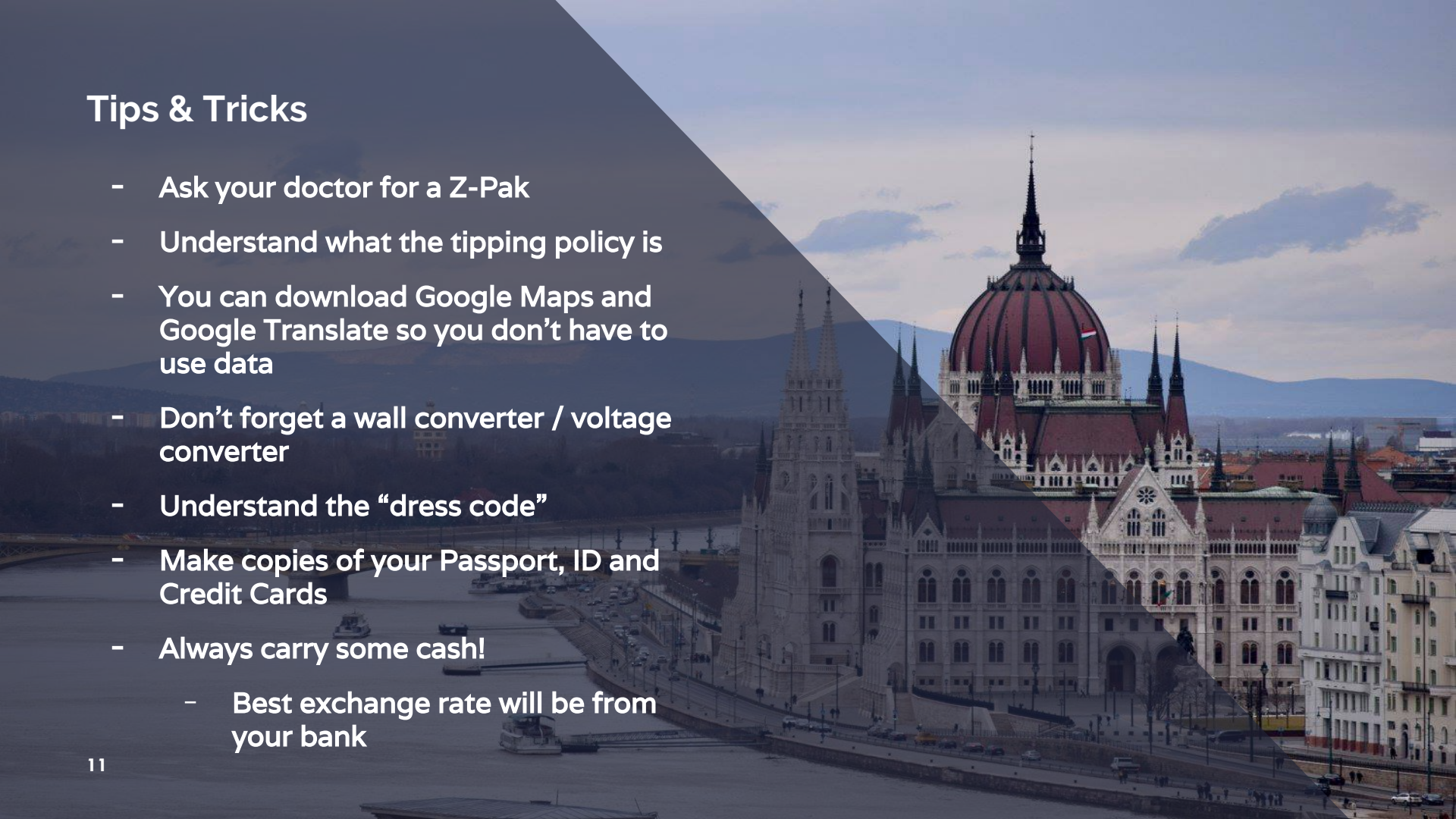
You can get a SIM card in every country you go to (can be found at gas stations or the airport). LTE speeds. Prices vary by country, but a relatively cheap option.

Daily Plan / WiFi

Most cellular companies offer daily plans, but they are expensive. I would use it as a last resort and rely on WiFi.

Tips & Tricks

- Ask your doctor for a Z-Pak
- Understand what the tipping policy is
- You can download Google Maps and Google Translate so you don't have to use data
- Don't forget a wall converter / voltage converter
- Understand the "dress code"
- Make copies of your Passport, ID and Credit Cards
- Always carry some cash!
 - Best exchange rate will be from your bank
